# Background

- Rosanna Li first studied ceramics in Hong Kong and then studied art education in the UK.
- LI was a founding member of the Contemporary Ceramic Society (HK) and taught at Hong Kong Polytechnic University's School of Design between 1990 and 2010.
- She received the Urban Council Fine Arts Award – Ceramics (1985), the Hong Kong Sculptor of the Year Award (1999), etc.

# Artistic style

- LI uses chubby ceramic figures to explore profound meanings in local lifestyle, culture and politics.
- Recently, she created several large-scale outdoor sculptures, which have brought her works closer to the community.
