## MUSEUM

Our new "Museum Feature" display introduces the "pi" which is a disc with a round perforation in the centre. Several jade and late neolithic pi's are exhibited, along with photographs, illustrations and explanatory text. Our other "Museum Feature" display of an old British sword continues for another month. The permanent display of Chinese antiquities remains unchanged.

### Children's Museum Competition (16th August - 30th September)

The aim of this competition is to encourage children to visit the museum and to study the items on display. Any person under 17 years old is eligible. To enter the competition, one should bring along colour pencils or fine colour felt-pens and ask for an entry card at the museum counter on any day between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. (except Thursdays and Sunday mornings) within the competition period. Awards will be presented to the best twenty candidates and also to ten schools which get the highest total marks acquired by their students in the competition.
